# Home hemodialysis is a treatment that you perform yourself at home.

### Is this type of dialysis for you?

- Yes, if you want more independence
- If you are having trouble with weight gain or managing your potassium or phosphorus
- If you want to manage your own schedule
- If you want to feel better
- · If you want to manage your treatments

### Definition

There are 2 types of home hemodialysis:

**Nocturnal home hemodialysis**: Treatments done 3 to 4 times a week that last around 8 hours. Done overnight.

**Daytime home hemodialysis**: Treatments done 4 to 5 times a week that last around 3 to 5 hours. Done during the day or in the evening.

### Criteria

To be eligible for home hemodialysis, you must:

- Own or rent your home
- Have good dexterity (skill with your hands)
- · Have a good memory
- · Have a phone line available during your treatment
- Have your nephrologist's approval that you are healthy enough for the treatment

### **Benefits**

Home hemodialysis has many benefits:

- Treatments in the comfort of your home
- A feeling of being more in control of your life
- Better quality of life
- Independence
- Freer schedule
- · Fewer hospital visits
- You can undergo dialysis longer and more often. This will make you feel better and reduce your food restrictions

#### Training

The training will give you the knowledge and confidence to perform hemodialysis treatments safely and independently at home. The training lasts 4 to 6 weeks and covers the following aspects:

- Operation of the hemodialysis machine and water filtration system
- Troubleshooting tips
- Disinfection procedures
- Safety checks
- · Cleaning and maintenance tips
