Visits to the Saint-Jérôme Regional Hospital resuming gradually

Saint-Jérôme, September 1, 2020 – The CISSS des Laurentides is happy to inform you that visits to the Saint-Jérôme Regional Hospital are gradually resuming.

Visits to hospitalized patients are now permitted, unless the patient is in a unit experiencing an outbreak or in a zone restricted to COVID-19-infected patients, to help prevent the spread of the virus. When in doubt, members of the public should confirm with the care unit that visits are permitted before going to the hospital.

Visits have been suspended since July 3, 2020, because of a COVID-19 outbreak which has since greatly improved. For Ms. Rosemonde Landry, President and Executive Director of the CISSS des Laurentides, “The situation is now sufficiently under control to allow visits in complete safety. We are pleased that loved ones can once again provide support to hospitalized patients and bring them comfort and encouragement.”

Stringent measures in Laurentian hospitals

As a preventive measure, visitors must respect certain guidelines, including complying with visiting hours and protection protocols.

Visits are limited to one person at a time, for a maximum of four visitors per day. For specific conditions in the various CISSS des Laurentides services, please visit the Visitors section of the www.santelaurentides.gouv.qc.ca website.
