Walk-in clinics extended for first doses

Saint-Jérôme, January 14, 2022 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides is prolonging the availability of COVID-19 vaccinations without an appointment for people wishing to get their first dose of vaccine. This service will continue to be available in all of the region's vaccination sites until further notice. Persons who are eligible to receive their second dose or booster shot must for their part book an appointment with Clic Santé. "Our vaccination capacity is increasing day by day at all of our vaccination sites. We invite anyone trying to get an appointment or who would like to change their appointment to an earlier date to check the clicsante.ca website regularly, as new time slots are being added continually. I want to take this opportunity to thank the staff at our vaccination sites for their commitment and for greatly contributing to increasing the availability of appointments at the present time," said Ms. Rosemonde Landry, President and Executive Director of the CISSS des Laurentides.

We want to remind individuals who have already contracted COVID-19 that they can get a booster shot, if they wish, as soon as they have no more symptoms. A minimum of three months must have elapsed between receiving the second dose and the booster shot. For complete information, visit quebec.ca.
