Opening of a second COVID-19 designated clinic in the Laurentians

Saint-Jérôme, March 24 2020 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides has been approved by the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux to open a second designated screening clinic in the northern sector of the Laurentian region.

Access to this diagnostic clinic is by appointment only.

COVID-19-screening clinics are a complementary measure intended for non-severe cases. Their purpose is to assist hospitals, family medicine clinics and public health teams in assessing patients. The addition of two clinics in the Laurentian region will make it possible to avoid overwhelming emergency departments and to prevent infected individuals from going to a non-designated medical clinic.

If you have any health concerns, the CISSS des Laurentides requests that you call the hotline at 1 877 644-4545 so that a nurse can assess your situation and make appropriate recommendations.

If you need to see a doctor, the nurse will direct you so that you can book an appointment.

Reminder

Access to both screening clinics in the Laurentian region is by appointment only. Persons who believe they are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must call 1-877-644-4545.
