COVID-19 vaccination

Over 500 000 vaccine doses have been administered in the Laurentians

Saint-Jérôme, June 21, 2021 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides is pleased to announce that over 500,000 doses have been administered in the region since the start of our COVID-19 vaccination campaign. Vaccinations continue at our ten vaccination centres in the Laurentians as well as aboard the Vaccibus that is crisscrossing the region.

Since its launch in December of last year, this operation, the first of its kind for the CISSS des Laurentides, has required deploying a large number of resources. From the logistics required to transport the material to the human resources, every sector is involved.

“We are very proud of the work we’ve done so far and are staying focused on our objective of administering two doses of vaccine to every eligible person in the Laurentians without delay, to ramp up the immunity protection of our entire population. We thank everyone involved in this campaign, which is continuing actively”, said Caroline Chantal, director of the COVID-19 vaccination campaign.

The public in the Laurentians can count on the CISSS des Laurentides’ eight vaccination sites throughout the region, as well as the Airbus and Bell Textron in-house vaccination sites, community pharmacies and the Vaccibus, a mobile vaccination unit that got underway on June 19.

The CISSS des Laurentides takes this opportunity to remind everyone, vaccinated or not, to continue complying with the current health regulations.
