In the coming days, the CISSS des Laurentides will provide more information about vaccination sites that will be relocating or closing.

“These changes are necessary as some of our partners, in particular arenas and recreational halls, will be resuming their normal activities. We have therefore had to reconsider the locations of some of our sites”, said Ms. Rosemonde Landry, President and Executive Director of the CISSS des Laurentides, in warmly thanking all the collaborators who contributed to setting up easily accessible public vaccination sites.

“The new sites have been chosen taking into account vaccination rates in each sector of our region. As a reminder, shuttle and escort services are available on demand by calling 1-877-644-4545. In addition, mobile vaccination teams will be put in place in every part of our region to continue outreach vaccinations”, added Ms. Landry.

Thus far, 85.5% of people in the Laurentians have received a first dose and 75% are fully vaccinated. We encourage individuals who have not received both doses of vaccine to visit one of the vaccination sites in the region, as it is the best way to protect themselves from COVID variants.
