Seniors aged 75 and over can now get a booster shot

Saint-Jérôme, November 17, 2021 - As of November 18, seniors aged 75 and over who live at home can book an appointment to get a COVID-19 booster shot at the various vaccinations sites in the region.

An interval of at least six months must have elapsed since the last vaccine dose.

“Anyone in this age group who has already received two vaccine doses can still receive a booster shot”, said Ms. Rosemonde Landry, President and Executive Director of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides.

To book an appointment online visit Quebec.ca/vaccinCOVID or use the NotifVAX mobile app. Persons lacking internet access or who have difficulty using it can call 1-877-644-4545 to obtain support. If necessary, family and friends are encouraged to help seniors make an appointment online. A free shuttle service is also available in the region for persons with reduced mobility who need to be accompanied or who lack transportation. To access this service, call 1-866-495-5833.
