

The Mont-Laurier vaccination site will soon be moving

Saint-Jérôme, September 3, 2021 – The COVID-19 vaccination campaign has been a resounding success and will continue for people aged 12 years and over. The CISSS des Laurentides wishes to inform the public that the Mont-Laurier vaccination site will soon be moving to a new address. “This change of venue is necessary as the theater must resume normal activities. We have therefore had to relocate the site, which will now move to the Centre sportif Jacques-Lesage”, said Ms. Rosemonde Landry, President and Executive Director of the CISSS des Laurentides.

“Individuals affected by the move do not need to do anything. Previously booked appointments will be honoured at the new site, at the agreed date and time. Some people may be contacted to change their appointment. It is important for the public to be aware of this address change, beginning September 21, to be able to go to the right location to get vaccinated”, added Ms. Landry. For those wishing to get vaccinated between the site closing and the one opening on September 21, shuttle and escort services are available on demand by calling 1-877-644-4545. In addition, mobile vaccination teams will be put in place in every part of our region to continue outreach vaccinations. Details are available on the vaccination page at santelaurentides.gouv.qc.ca.

So far, 75% of the population in the MRC Antoine-Labelle have been fully vaccinated. “The public is asked to move up their appointment for a second COVID-19 shot at one of our vaccination sites. A minimum interval of 4 weeks between doses is required. Getting vaccinated is the best way to protect against variants of the virus”, concluded the President and Executive Director.
