New paediatric clinics in the Laurentians for children without a family doctor

Saint-Jérôme, September 24, 2021 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides is opening three new clinics for children aged 3 months to 16 years requiring care for minor health issues.

A child whose parent wishes to make an appointment must meet the following criteria:

- Must be without a family doctor or specialised nurse practitioner;
- Must have a minor health issue.

To allow for greater public access, these clinics are by appointment only in Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts, Saint-Jérôme and Boisbriand.

These designated paediatric clinics aim to provide an additional alternative for families in the Laurentians. In so doing, these clinics will support the region's emergency departments and family medical clinics.

Stringent prevention measures are in force at these clinics. We ask for everyone's cooperation in following the rules in place.
